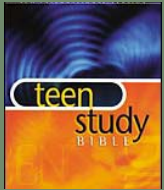


Welcome to Wednesday Family Night

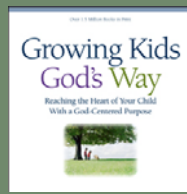
